Project Summary

Nebraska Prepared Communities Initiative

The American Red Cross prevents and alleviates human suffering in the face of emergencies by mobilizing the power of volunteers and the generosity of donors. We help individuals and communities prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters.

The American Red Cross does not depend on fixed locations and buildings to provide services. Volunteers are the community presence of the Red Cross throughout Nebraska and make up 94% of the Red Cross leadership and workforce. They are prepared to help anywhere and at any time they are needed.

The Nebraska Prepared Communities Initiative (PCI) is a coordinated effort within the five lines of service and support departments of the American Red Cross in the State of Nebraska. This program will assist communities with preparing for emergencies and disasters. Blood Services, Disasters Cycle Services, International Services, Preparedness Health and Safety Services (PHSS), and Services to Armed Forces (SAF) have combined their efforts with the goal of assisting individuals and communities in preparing for, responding to, and recovering from emergencies and disasters. This will expand and enhance the presence of the American Red Cross in each community.

Each line of service and department of the American Red Cross will work together to achieve three levels of preparedness in each community. These levels will be a stair step process systematically building our foundation in each community. We will complete the PCI in 100 Nebraska communities by December 2018, and will continue the PCI until we complete our efforts in each of the communities in Nebraska in 2020.

Level I will consist of four objectives:

- Volunteer recruitment in each community.
- Update/develop a shelter agreement to provide shelter for each community in the event of an emergency or disaster.
- Document 25 or more volunteer hours in each community.
- Introduce the Preparedness Health and Safety Services (PHSS) Ready Rating program (ReadyRating.org) to each community.

Level II will consist of one objective: developing and promoting activities from two or more of the following departments in each community:

- Blood Services (blood drive, speaking engagement, Pint Size Hero Program, etc.)
- Services to the Armed Forces (SAF) (Holiday Cards for Heroes, Get to Know Us Before You Need Us, special events, etc.)
- International Services (Presentation on International Services, host class, etc.)

Level III will consist of the development of an American Red Cross Engagement Plan which will outline the long-term goals and objectives of the American Red Cross in each community throughout Nebraska.

When we have completed each level in a community, our efforts will then transition to working to achieve the long-term goals and objectives created in each of the Engagement Plans that have been created for the Nebraska communities.

Project Leadership

The Executive Director in each chapter area will be the PCI project lead and will work with each department head or their designee to complete each level of the PCI.

Communities

For the purpose of the PCI, the definition of communities will be counties, cities, villages, and any location identified as a census-designated place by the United States Census Bureau.

PCI Groupings

To streamline our planning process and maximize resources, we will be placing counties, cities, villages, and census-designated places into groupings. The groupings will allow us to better manage our planning efforts by focusing on specific geographic areas. We will manage our PCI planning efforts based on the established grouping boundaries. We will not be limited by the boundaries when implementing the PCI and fully intend to overlap our efforts between the groupings throughout the initiative. A city will be identified in each grouping to serve as a location for centralized meetings and events during the PCI, and the name of the city will be used as the grouping name.

The groupings and the grouping names are for the purpose of the PCI only. When the PCI is complete, the grouping boundaries and names will no longer be used.

PCI Timeline/Implementation

The Executive Director in each chapter area will determine the planning and implementation timeline for the PCI in their area. A statewide timeline for the start of the PCI in each grouping has been created and we will start our PCI efforts based on this timeline (Pages 14-18). Although it is our plan to follow this timeline, the Executive Directors will have the discretion to move forward or delay a start date based on opportunities and available resources to ensure the success of the PCI in that grouping.

As we prepare to implement the PCI in a community, the Executive Director will contact the elected officials, government partners, community partners, and media partners in the grouping and introduce the PCI and detail our goals and objectives in their community.

We will be moving forward with multiple PCI groupings simultaneously and will work with the communities in each grouping for as long as it takes to complete the goals and levels of the initiative. We will complete the PCI in 100 Nebraska communities by December 2018, and will continue our efforts until we have completed the PCI in each Nebraska community. We plan to have the PCI completed by January 2020.

As we complete the PCI in a community, a completion report will be written detailing what we have done in the community and we will outline our Engagement Plan. A copy of the PCI completion report and Engagement Plan will be sent to each of the elected officials, our partners, and the media in the community.

With the completion of the PCI, the efforts of the American Red Cross will transition to achieving the goals and objectives of each Engagement Plan.

Lines of Service

Blood Services

The American Red Cross is the largest single supplier of blood and blood products in the United States. Each year, nearly 4 million people donate blood through the Red Cross, helping to provide more than 40% of America's blood supply.

Disaster Cycle Services

The Red Cross responds to approximately 70,000 disasters in the United States every year, ranging from home fires that affect a single family, to hurricanes that affect tens of thousands, to earthquakes that impact millions. In these events, the Red Cross provides shelter, food, health and mental health services to help families and entire communities get back on their feet. Although the Red Cross is not a government agency, it is an essential part of the response when disaster strikes. We work in partnership with other agencies and organizations that provide services to disaster victims.

International Services

The American Red Cross is part of the world's largest humanitarian network with 13 million volunteers in 187 countries. Working together, we help respond to disasters, build safer communities, and educate about international humanitarian law. Each year, we reach an average of more than 100 million people across the globe.

Preparedness, Health and Safety Services

The Red Cross is the nation's leading provider of health and safety courses, such as CPR, First Aid and Lifeguard training. Each year, more than 9 million Americans participate in our training programs, including first responders, educators, babysitters, and people who want to be prepared to help others in an emergency.

Service to Armed Forces

The Red Cross helps military members, veterans and their families prepare for, cope with, and respond to the challenges of military service. Emergency communications, training, support to wounded warriors and veterans, and access to community resources help an average of 150,000 military families and veterans annually.

Project Goals

- Enhance the presence of the American Red Cross in each community.

Project Levels

Level I

Level I – Objective 1

Volunteer recruitment in each community.

Lead Department: Volunteer Services

Participating Department(s): All

The American Red Cross has conducted a Volunteer Needs Assessment in the State of Nebraska to identify the volunteer needs of each of our departments to fulfill our current mission within Nebraska. American Red Cross volunteers make up 94% of our workforce. They allow us to strategically train volunteers throughout Nebraska to lead and assist our efforts in helping communities prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters. Using the Volunteer Needs Assessment, Volunteer Services will recruit volunteers in each grouping area.

Volunteer Services will work with each department during the PCI to continuously evaluate volunteer workforce needs and volunteer opportunities throughout Nebraska. As new volunteer needs and opportunities are identified, Volunteers Services will recruit in the identified areas.



Level I – Objective 2

Update/develop shelter agreements to provide shelter for each community in the event of an emergency or disaster.

Lead Department: Disaster Cycle Services

Participating Department(s): Disaster Cycle Services

Disasters Cycle Services will work with the emergency management officials in each community to identify shelter locations that can be utilized by communities after an emergency or disaster, and then updated and developed shelter agreements for these locations. Shelter agreements will allow the American Red Cross to quickly open emergency shelters for clients to stay when their homes have been damaged or destroyed by disasters.



Level I – Objective 3

Document 25 or more volunteer hours in each community.

Lead Department: Volunteer Services

Participating Department(s): Volunteer Services

Volunteer Services will record the amount of volunteer hours that are worked in each community. Before December 2018, the American Red Cross will document a minimum of 25 volunteer hours in 100 communities. The hours will continue to be documented in each grouping until the PCI is completed statewide.



Level I – Objective 4

Introduce the Preparedness, Health and Safety Services (PHSS) Ready Rating program to each community.

Lead Department: Joint Effort – PHSS/Executive Director

Participating Department(s): PHSS, Development, and Executive Director

The Ready Rating program is a free website, ReadyRating.com, which is offered by PHSS to help organizations and communities to better prepare, respond, and recover from emergencies and disasters. We will be introducing the website to each community, and encourage organizations to visit the website to use the free tools to help better prepare for emergencies and disasters.



Level II

Develop and promote activities from two or more of the following departments in each community:

- Blood Services (blood drive, speaking engagement, Pint Size Hero Program, etc.)
- Services to the Armed Forces (SAF) (Holiday Card for Heroes, Get to Know Us Before You Need Us, special events, etc.)

Lead Department: Joint Effort – Blood Services, SAF, International Services, and Executive Director

Participating Department(s): Blood Services, SAF, International Services, and Executive Director

Blood Services, SAF, and International Services are a part of the American Red Cross' effort to help individuals, families, and communities prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters. We will be promoting the services of these departments and developing ways of enhancing the services in each community.



Level III

Create an American Red Cross Engagement Plan for each community.

Lead Department: Executive Director

Participating Department(s): All

The Executive Director will work with each American Red Cross department to identify the needs of each community and develop a long-term Engagement Plan for how the American Red Cross will help to enhance the community's ability to effectively prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters.

Once the PCI is completed in a community, the Executive Director will prepare a report outlining our efforts. The report and the Engagement Plan will be sent to the elected officials, government partners, and the media in each community. When we have completed each level and objective in a community, our efforts will be transitioned to working to achieve the long-term goals and objectives created in each of the Engagement Plans that have been created in each Nebraska community.


